title: Market access: workers as migrants

Abstract:

This contribution aims to discuss how the notion of inclusion has been increasingly conceptualised, by the EU's policy-makers and judges, in terms of 'market access'

A different 'geography of law' redraws the map of Europe in terms of the competitive alignment of national systems of worker protection. Market access has been increasingly understood as 'entry point' and modality of participation in economic activity which, under total market thinking, makes inclusion coincident with social dumping.
